1) The introduction is concise and gives enough information about the studied problem worldwide. Moreover, the importance of the problem is emphasized.

2) About the part "Methodology":

The Study Design, Sample Size, Sample Collection and Sample Processing are well described.

Statistical methods are relevant to the design of the study.

3) In the section "Results" in five tables are mentioned all findings about the studied problem. The order of the tables follows the logical structure of the study.

4) In Discussion the authors compared their results with other studies upon the problem. The specificity of the discussed problem is well described.

5) At the end of my notes I want to say that the study correctly highlights that "The majority of the patients were of the age group 30-39 years whose wound infection was majorly (93.5%) due to pyogenic bacteria."
