

Editor's Comment:

Regarding the manuscript intitled "**The Rate of Adherence to Antibiotics and Reasons for Non-Adherence Among the Public**" which was recently resubmitted to our Scientific Journal, I should say that despite the fact that the author has accepted all the suggestions from our reviewers, there are several inconsistencies that should be mentioned.

First of all, the english should be enhanced, there are several grammar mistakes, besides, results and methodology section were written in the present tense, which should be in the past. I strongly recommend to send the manuscript to a professional or any native english speaker for further revision.

The sampling of the survey is one of the strong points from this survey, however, the author did not mention any time, where the survey was taken.

Although this survey is part of an important field called Pharmacoepidemiology, the author did not mention this field in any part of the manuscript, just wrote "retrospective study". Moreover, he does not say from which references the questionnaire was developed or inspired? According to Pharmacoepidemiology there are several types of questionnaires that are helpfull to lead the researcher.

Regarding the questionnaire questions: "Did you ever forget your antimicrobial drugs in the past two weeks?" why this question? Was not the questionnaire about who had antibiotics prescribed during the last year?

To sum up, for original research paper, we strongly advise a lenght of 3000 - 6000 words, and this manuscript reaches 2500 words (including refrences), additionally, there is a lack of novelty from this work, which could be easily accepted as a congress or symposium abstract. Therefore, I recommend the rejection of this manuscript to the Journal of Pharmaceutical Research International.
