Events of a nutritional and hormonal nature that occur simultaneously with the maturation process will certainly lead to irreversible repercussions that will compromise the woman's future life conditions.</p> <p>One of the most important aspects concerns the dispute for nutrients that occurs between adolescent and fetus, mainly in relation to the needs for calcium, a fundamental element for the bone structure that is being formed during puberty.</p>
