<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Referring to page 1, author stated that 'It is one of the five main stages of a man's life.' Hence, it is suggested if the author can elaborate on the other 4 main stages of a man's life.</li> <li>2. The latest citation should be highlighted. Referring to page 2, 13% of the total population remains in this age all over the world (2017) seems outdated.</li> <li>3. Referring to page 2, it is noted that 'The President also declared the elderly people as the 'Senior Citizens' of the state and urged people about their social security, dignity, and all other facilities [9]'; however, it may better if any current statistic or data upon the issue of Bangladeshi senior citizens can be highlighted in this section.</li> <li>4. Referring to page 2, author claimed that 'there are a lot of incidents which are examples of human rights violation'; therefore, pls provide evidence to support this statement.</li> <li>5. Also, pls provide a clear definition of all the key issues in this study (eg. Senior citizens, political, administrative and economic challenges) in the introduction section.</li> <li>6. Referring to Research Methodology section at page 2, pls clearly explain on the number of respondents who involved in the questionnaire method, and number of informants who involved in the face-to-face interview.</li> <li>7. Referring to Research Methodology section at page 2, pls also explain on the type of data analysis which has been used for both approaches (quantitative, qualitative) of the study.</li> <li>8. Referring to Research Methodology section at page 2, no information on the population has been mentioned for this study.</li> <li>9. Referring to Research Methodology section at page 2, it is stated that 'Rajshahi Sadar Upazila is divided into four model Thanas (Police stations)'. Pls elaborate.</li> <li>10. Referring to Research Methodology section at page 2, no explanation is touched on the sources of the secondary data which has been used in this study.</li> <li>11. Referring to Research Methodology section at page 2, no explanation is given on both of the used questionnaire (quantitative) as well as the face-to-face interview questions (qualitative) either in the aspects of open nor close ended questions.</li> <li>12. The section of results and discussion has been discussed in a good sequence, and easy for readers to understand. However, it is suggested if the results can be discussed in detail by highlighting the <b>sources of information (primary, secondary)</b> and how the results have been obtained.</li> <li>13. The section of conclusion and recommendations has been discussed in a good sequence, and easy for readers to understand. However, it is suggested if the conclusion can be linked with the 3 important key terms as per highlighted in the previous section namely <b>political, administrative</b> and <b>economic</b> challenges.</li> </ol>
