Whose results also allow proposals on some of the weaknesses such as that they do not produce fish feeds and others such as the lack of use of ICT, to mention a few.	
Minor REVISION comments	Two proposals: 1. In addition to the location of the fishing farms, it would be worthwhile in a brief explanation their type in terms of ownership, number of producers, type of fish and the general production process, so that the reader better understands the context in which they are located and apply these extension programs. 2. Explain how the oil companies in the area help and promote this type of program, especially when we think of other countries where most of them are only extractors and cause great damage to both the population and the environment.
