Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>This paper is an example of a demonstration lesson for students eager to find new therapeutic principles. It can be a starting point for the discovery of a new molecule with a hemostatic or antibiotic role. The extracts obtained do not bring a notable benefit in hemostasis. The antibiotic role in acute bacterial meningoenkephalitis cannot even be questioned. This disease is an immediate medical emergency, with a significant risk of death requiring an antibiotic with penetrability in the cerebrospinal fluid, administered within one hour of the patient's presentation in the emergency department and reevaluated after identifying the germ and its antibiotic sensitivity, depending on patient evolution. The research should be continued with the identification of the antibiotic substance, its purification and the demonstration of cerebrospinal fluid penetration and role in vivo. Phytotherapy is a long-term therapy useful in chronic diseases and less in severe acute bleeding or acute bacterial meningitis. Paragraph 3.2 probably discusses table2. The research has a didactic role but no use in clinical medical practice.</p>
