Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The paper is interesting. It needs some editing (in particular, spacing). We recommend to accept it after its grammatical errors are corrected.</p> <p>E.g. The spacing after "." (period or full stop) is not consistent. >> In Abstract (3rd line): "... procedure. .. The modified ..." (this is a double space). While other places in the paper use single space. >> On page 1, second paragraph. There is no spacing before the new sentence "This algorithm follows the pioneer work ...". >> On page 1, last paragraph. There is no spacing before the new sentence "The Robbins and Monroe ...".</p> <p>Other spacing issues: >> In Abstract: too much spacing between "Stochastic" and "Approximation". >> On page 1, second paragraph. Too much spacing between "present" and "problem". Also too much spacing right after "Monroe" in the same sentence. >> On page 1, second paragraph. There is an extra spacing after "root" (in "sought for root"). >> On page 1, last paragraph. Too much spacing between "Monroe" and "stochastic". >> On page 1, last paragraph. Too much spacing between "algorithm" and "establishes".</p> <p>There are other issues. By default, Microsoft Word automatically indicates grammatical errors (including spacing issues). These errors are indicated by green wavy lines. We recommend the author(s) to take advantage of this feature and function of Word.</p>
