| <p>Compulsory REVISION comments</p> | <p>Title of the manuscript under review: Effect of ascorbic acid on glyphosate-induced hematological and serological pathology in juvenile catfish (<i>Clarias gariepinus</i>) Manuscript number: Ms_AJRAVS_62442 Content of the review: Title - Include/plasma the classifier of the species under investigation, the <i>Clarias gariepinus</i>; that is, the author who classified it and the year he did so (Burdrell, 1882) - The order and family of the species under analysis/research must be shown in parentheses SUMMARY - It is structured and well conceived, just review in the Methodology, specifically the penultimate line, since there are two points and then, when it is only one - Keywords, would be much better ordered alphabetically 1. INTRODUCTION - Why does the first paragraph not have a margin to the right of the first line, while the rest of the paragraphs do (2nd and 3rd)? - It uses a total of 12 bibliographic references in that section/academic, out of a total of 40 in the whole manuscript, which is equivalent to 30%, but only four are from the last ten years (10%), while eight are from before the last ten years, for 20%, but none are from the last five years 2. MATERIAL AND METHODS - When referring to ordinal numbers, from 1 to 10, it should be done/plasmatized with letters, as in the cases of the third paragraph (in four juveniles), and the fifth paragraph (in three labeled replicas) -In the seventh paragraph, another 144 what? 3. RESULTS - Review the first two paragraphs, as they lack a margin to the right of the first line, as well as the last paragraph of that section/accord 4.
