It is suggested to include clinical and diagnostic characteristics of BCS in introduction part to give an over view to reader. 2- In discussion part, Author has reported corticosteroid therapy @ 40-60 mg/kg/day. The question is whether it is valid for any corticosteroid or for specific name. 3-
