Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The interest of the research which was to investigate the "origin of the worship of mother goddess" in Vietnam was successfully achieved. It addresses the spiritual powers and provisions of the mother figure which is devotedly expressed through the worship of mother goddess in Vietnam. This was thoughtfully examined from different perspectives. The work did not undermine important social and moral issues and therefore, in alignment with important research ethics. There are commendable supporting references to buttress the points raised. However, there should be a discussion on the folk religions of Vietnamese, hence the article intended to "help readers have a more complete and comprehensive view of the folk religion's origin that is expression of Vietnamese people". That will also help to contribute in solving the problem of "whether the worship of the Mother Goddess is a complete religion or just a folk religion", which is highlighted in the second point. There should be avoidance of such colloquial statements like, "As we all know", "we must consider" (see introduction, last paragraph). Such first person pronouns should be avoided in order to be dispassionate and objective. This can suggest that the research is unique to the author's perspective. Focus should be on the idea and not the author. Almost in all the points raised, some paragraphs should be merged for unity of idea and coherence.</p> <p>The geographical area of study should be incorporated in the topic for better understanding, "Origin of the Worship of Mother Goddess in Vietnam" would be ideal.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	There are some grammatical errors that need to be revisited. They have been highlighted in red.
