Compulsory REVISION comments	The article is very interesting and the subject is very topical, precisely to improve it I would suggest providing a much more recent bibliography, since at the moment there is a large production in specific centers of European prestige such as Oxford University or Rey Juan Carlos University in SPAIN, It would have been interesting to include historical activity from Europe, specifically the United Kingdom and countries that are the epicenter of the applications of dance in therapy, pioneers in its clinical implementation at the hospital and primary care level, such as Cuba, which created the first art therapy system based on in classical dance, the psychoballet recognized by UNESCO and adapted in many countries, or the experiences of Israel. In Europe, numerous doctoral theses are being carried out on these topics, specifically in Alzheimer's and dementias and other diseases with cognitive degeneration, such as Parkinson's, in cancer and psychiatric diseases. There are referents with wide visibility published in high impact magazines and a lot of activity in fields of social action and with populations with functional diversity	
Minor REVISION comments	Update the bibliography, there are only four recent citations, one from 2015, and two from 2016 and two from 2020. However, in the last five years the academic and scientific production of clinical applications of dance is very broad and relevant
