The abstract content is not written neatly because there are some parts of the paragraph that are not aligned right - left (justify alignment) 2. The author has not followed the template in which the contents of the article must be divided into several parts including introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, a conclusion 3. The author has not included the research methodology 4. The author is unable to describe the role of climate management in India 5. Reference is still all wrong, do not use roman numerals, write the year at the back and follow the page 6. Adding to the theory in the last 5 years because the refrence is still relatively lacking 	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>The research methodology needs to be described and the contents of the article must be divided into several parts including an introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, a conclusion</p>
