Compulsory REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In the introduction authors mentioned data from National Bureau of Statistics and KPMG report, but did not provide references for this. Also, in the introduction part, third paragraph is not clear, i.e. the second sentence is not finished, so the reader do not understand what authors want to say. Some references made in the text are not in the reference list at the end, i.e. Barro (1990); Helms, 1995; Mendoza et al., 1997. Foresti (2006) in text, while Foresti (2007) in the reference list The Table 1 should provide ADF critical value of 10% since the explanation below table is based on these values. If someone looks at this Table without those values it cannot see the reason to reject the null hypothesis, except for PVTEMPg. Table in the part 4.3. Granger causality tests do not have heading. Also, fourth and fifth column in this Table have the same heading. Table 4 – fourth and fifth column have the same heading. Decision column is not correct for third row, sixth, seventh and tenth. Also DW statistics should be included in the Table. Aschauer, D.A. (1993), Euractive (2010), ILO (2010), UNCTAD (2008) are not stated in the text but in the reference list only.
