<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The author should revise the use of traditional method of cointegration (eigenvalue) and consider a more conventional method since results of unit root test indicate a mix of the order of integration (i. e. I(0) and I(1)). For example, bounds test approach of ARDL model will be more appropriate.</li> <li>Addition of figures to depict trend analysis and behaviour of the core variables will add more values to the study.</li> <li>The author should provide adequate citations for categorical statements made in the work to enhance its quality and credibility. These are grossly missing and hence, constitute a common flaw in the study.</li> </ol>
