<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p><b>Introduction</b></p> <p>The introduction is very large and very messy information on different topics related to human intervention on forest resources and the strategies applied to the management and conservation of resources. Great Stand of the information collected in this section corresponds to the section discussion of the results.</p> <p><b>Methodology</b></p> <p>The manuscript presents an incomplete methodology, without a well - defined experimental design. The methodology does not specify what variables recorded in the questionnaires of 568 respondents (randomly selected).</p> <p>Similarly, the methodology lacks specifications for both parametric and no parametric statistical analysis (for quantitative and qualitative variables).</p> <p><b>Results and Discussion</b></p> <p>Results and discussion about the influence farmers' attitude towards deforestation, is rather poor and does not provide new knowledge. Lacking analyze information under the application of a non-parametric ANOVA (Friedman test or Kruskal-Wallis test) based on strata. The results also failed to analyze the survey results by Chi-square test.</p> <p><b>References</b></p> <p>Collating references cited in the text with the literature, since there are references in the literature that were not recorded in the text and vice versa.</p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>Lines 3-4, remove the period at the end of title.</p> <p><b>Abstract</b></p> <p>To publicize the outstanding results in terms of numbers on the qualitative and quantitative information such as the results of a survey of <b>568 randomly selected Respondents</b>.</p> <p>Specify the non - parametric statistical analysis applied to the results.</p> <p>Line 24: add the following words to the Key words: "Farmer's attitude" Change the following lines: Lines 46-47: "(Philip, Harrison, Akintoye, Olorundami, Nkpena &amp; kata, 2014)." to "Philip et al., (2014)".</p> <p>Line 48: "Philip et al (2014)" to "Philip et al., (2014)".</p> <p>Lines 57-58: "(Shuwa, Shettima, Makinta, &amp; Kyari, 2014)" to "(Shuwa et al., 2014)."
