Too many repeated statement on the same points, issues or aspects which need to be minimized and consolidated.</li> <li>2. The sampling only 1.43% of the total population which is too small and not representative of the whole population.</li> <li>3. Results and discussion were based on perception or opinion of the unrepresented population and hypothesis only without cross check with related medical reports for confirmation.</li> <li>4. Discussion should elaborate further the results or statistic shown by the tables and figures which will be leading to the general conclusion.</li> <li>5. Only 8.33% of references are the recent therefore needs more recent references (less than 5 years).</li> <li>6. No referred appendix included in the manuscript.</li> </ol>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	Title of the figure should be at the bottom of the figure.	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	In general, the study revealed that the physical & mental health problems are due to lack of availability of the related facilities and poor management of the healthcare and environmental control, and others sosio-economic problems, not only due to oil exploration activities.
