The risks should be quantified as high risk, moderate risk, mild risk or no risk.</p> <p>Table4: title should be" Frequency of use of CL during Pandemic". Column 4 of the table "other" not explained.</p> <p>Figure 4 not explained</p> <p>Discussion: As per Fig 3 only 6 to 11% of participants have stopped CL use due to fear of infection. The majority have attributed other causes, eg. lifestyle changes. Hence it cannot be surmised that "8 out of 10 CL wearers had probably the fear of virus infection at the back of their head" as mentioned in discussion.</p> <p>Conclusion will also have to be modified to include all causes of reduction of CL wear.</p> <p>.</p>
