I suggest including this value and rewriting the text. In methodology, indicate the ethical aspect of the study. Approval by an ethics committee; if there was an informed consent, etc. In fig, 3: clarify that (a) is a figure of man and (b) a figure of women	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	The study has clarity in its title, objectives and methodology. The results are important to publish, observing that more than 70% of the children in Anganwadi were anemic. An interesting result is the association of childhood anemia with maternal anemia and barefoot walking. I suggest its publication in the Journal after raising minor observations.
