<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-More detail about the isolate should be provide, referring as agglutination test (if possible), <i>Vibrio fluvialis</i> specie determination cannot be done only by Gram-staining.</li> <li>-A picture of bacteria is necessary (i.e. growth plate, Gram-staining, transmission electron microscopy).</li> <li>-There is no test for O-129, and TCBS media growth specific for <i>Vibrio</i> sp. Isolation</li> <li>-Additionally, no 16S RNA gene sequencing to identify <i>Vibrio</i> species</li> </ul>

<b>Optional/General</b> comments	Overall, the manuscript described a new case of <i>Vibrio fluvialis</i> with a rare infection source from fresh water utilized for agriculture (non-seafood consumption) and a tissue necrosis and pedal oedema. Clinical profile was stated through the process with a successful recovery due to antibiotic treatment.
