<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>The study sought to determine the predictors of severe perineal rupture, its rate and the maternal and fetal demographic risk factor associated with it.</p> <p>Subject widely studied worldwide, but relevant and original for Yenagoa due to the scarcity of this type of study. Due to the magnitude of the problem and the variety of risk factors for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> degree tear, knowing the predictors of a given population is an opportunity to care for women's sexual and reproductive health.</p>
