Sometimes there are new paragraphs while talking about the same topic. I am pretty sure the parasites name is Strongyloides stercoralis. I found a little confusing the way you present your results, furthermore, some tables were moved and that made it more difficult to review the results. I strongly recommend explaining the significance of P values and discuss them, especially when P is <0.05 There are large paragraphs with few references and although I assume they are from only one or two sources, it seems that the reference is missing. Some tables were moved and that
